Project Narrative

The proposed improvements to the Godley Elementary School include additional parking, an exterior canopy, a new classroom addition, a new activity center addition and interior renovations in various areas.

New parking will be constructed within the existing front entry bus loop for visitors and school staff. Also, a new canopy will be installed, replacing the existing canopy, to protect the parent pick-up and drop-off area.

A new classroom addition will be constructed along the South side of the elementary school. The program includes space for 10 classrooms, a resource classroom, a computer lab, two large storage rooms and student and staff restrooms. The corridor connection to the new addition will start in the existing South corridor and push through an existing classroom. The space on the other side of the existing classroom will be divided for a new PTO workroom and new storage for the existing gym.

The new classrooms will be arranged with 24 cubbies with storage above, a teacher's wardrobe, storage shelves, a 16 foot writing surface, a 4 foot tack board, a projector screen and technology for four computer stations.

The computer lab will be equipped with a continuous built-in counter around the perimeter wall to support 22 workstations and two printer stations. The teaching wall will also have a 16 foot writing surface along with a 4 foot tack board. Next to the computer lab will be a resource classroom with similar classroom arrangements.

A new activity center addition will be constructed on the North side of the elementary school. The program includes space for an activity center to match the size of the existing activity center, an office and storage space for gym equipment. The program also includes student restrooms that have direct access to the activity room. The corridor connection to the new addition will start in the existing North corridor and push through an existing classroom. The

space on the other side of the existing classroom will be divided for a new speech classroom and storage space.

The existing activities center will be renovated to include replacing the existing lights, replacing the flooring and painting the walls.

The existing cafetorium will receive new flooring. The stage will also be renovated to allow better sight lines by widening the stage opening on each side.

The kitchen will be arranged to provide two serving lines. A new walk-in freezer will be constructed on the South side. Outdated kitchen equipment will be replaced with existing equipment from the Intermediate School.

The library will be enlarged by removing the existing computer lab to be used for additional stack area. Flooring, ceiling and lighting will also be replaced throughout the library.

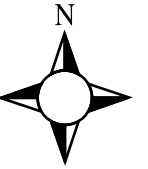
